Tri Team Rules – 2014 Provincial Agility

What is it?

It is a competition in which teams of 3 dogs and their handlers combine the best of their team scores in each course. The team with the highest score wins!

Note: All participants must be entered in the 2014 Québec Provincial

Rules:

- Team name!!
- Three (3) dogs and three (3) handlers per team
- One (1) person cannot run multiple dogs in the same team
- The same dog cannot run in more than one (1) team
- The handler can run on multiple teams but with different dogs
- Maximum of one (1) veteran dog per team (due to the possible increase in points)
- The total in each event for each handler (18) in total: 2 Standards, 2 Jumpers and 2 Gamblers per handler) must be entered on the scorecards to accumulate the total team score
- Scorecards will be provided and must be submitted, in the box that will be provided for this purpose, at the end of each day. Each team is responsible in the accumulation of their points
- Scores will be verified before the awards
- The team with the highest cumulative score will be awarded the title of "Tri Team 2014" Provincial Agility and a cash prize.
- The amount to be awarded to the winning team will be based on the number of entries. So, the more teams that are entered, the greater the amount!
- The first 3 teams will also receive ribbons
- The result of the Tri Team will be announced during the closing ceremony.

Entry fees

- The entry fee is \$5.00 per dog
 - Fill out the form included in the 2014 Provincial Agility form. The form should include your name and the name of the 2 other members of your team.

It is possible to include the « Triple 3/Tri Team » entry fee with your entry and payment of the 2014 Provincial Agility..
